About Naperville Area Humane Society

In 1979, a group of caring citizens dedicated themselves to helping homeless companion animals in their community. Forty years later, the Naperville Area Humane Society (NAHS) continues to be a leader of animal welfare in the community. From innovative programming to investments in outreach and advocacy, we continue to promote the humane treatment of companion animals by creating lasting human animal bonds.

Every year we care for more than 700 cats and dogs in need and aid hundreds more through programs that help people care for their pets.

NAHS is a 501(c)(3) non-profit, limited admission animal shelter that can house as many as eighteen dogs and forty cats. Entering a shelter can be stressful



or possibly even terrifying to some cats and dogs, which is why our dedicated and highly trained staff and volunteers offer compassionate care to each animal and work to address his or her individual needs.

In additional to adoption, NAHS offers services and support for the community, including:

- Education programs and camps for children
- A free behavior helpline that provides caring pet advice and resources
- Animal assisted therapy programs that include, Pawsitive Therapy, Paws for Tales, and Project Pawsitive Future
- Two funds dedicated to powerful causes: Lucky 7 Fund, for senior pets, and our Pets for Vets Fund, that pairs emotional support animals with veterans and/or first responders
- Partnering with local businesses for adoption events and fundraising opportunities

NAHS does not receive any government funding, and our work is solely funded by private donations, merchandise sales, special events, and adoption and program fees.

For over 20 years, the Black Cat Ball is the premiere gala in Naperville held yearly in October. Highlights include an elegant night of cocktails, dinner, champagne pull, auctions, dancing, and casino all embedded in a mission-focused program. Each year over 200 attendees help raise more than \$65,000 to support NAHS and our programs

For 25 years, the Putts for Pets Golf Outing has been a community favorite. Held every summer, the event attracts over 150 golfers and community leaders. Putts for Pets includes 18 holes of golf, breakfast, late lunch, on-course beverages, prizes and auctions.
